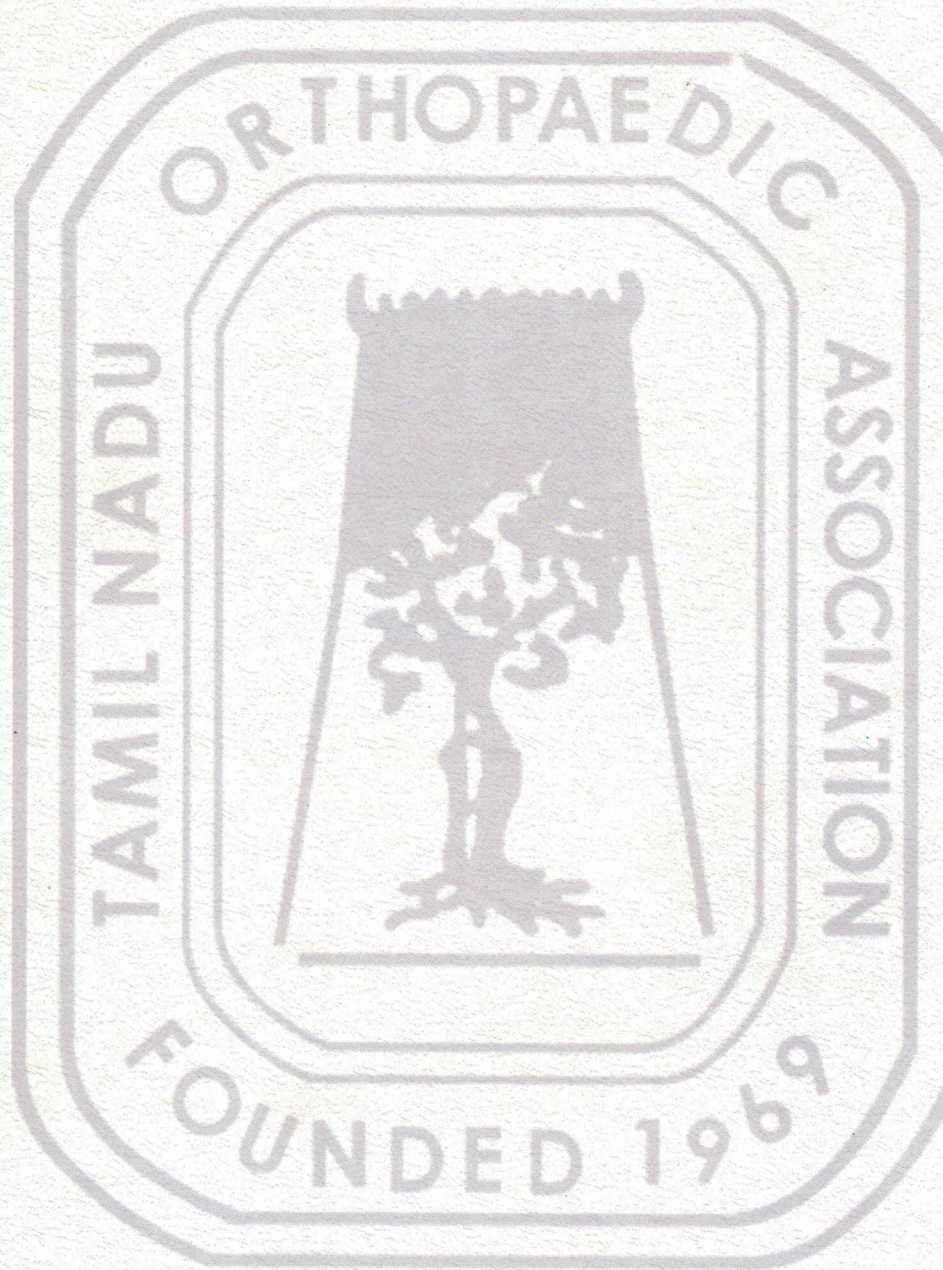

Minutes of the Executive Committee meeting of TNOA conducted on the 18th of September, 2005 at Genny Club, Coimbatore.

The President of the Association, Dr. V. Shanmugam called the meeting to order and welcomed the committee members. He congratulated Dr. P. V. Jayasankar for the successful conduct of the TNOA Arthroplasty course, which was the first such course conducted on behalf of the TNOA.

Recognition of Achievements:

Dr.C. Raja Ravi Varma, at the request of the President read out the various achievements of the members of TNOA viz. L-RAMP Award for Innovations in Custom Mega Prosthesis won by Prof Mayilvahanan Natarjan, the HARI-OM ASHRAM ALEMBIC RESEARCH AWARD, MACNAB LA ROCCA AWARD AND INSTITUT DE FRACE-FOUNDTION YVES COTREL awards – all won by Dr. S. Rajasekaran of Coimbatore and the IOA J&J Fellowship by Dr. Nalli R Uvaraj.

Dr. A. Chandrasekaran attended a fellowship on Deformity Correction at Portgal. Dr. B.R. Ramasubramaniam was awarded the IMA Award and Fellow of the Royal College of General Practioners for maximum (more than 50) academic presentations in IMA meetings.

Prof. M. Chidambaram, Vice President TNOA, was elected Senate Member of Dr. M.G.R Medical University from Madurai and Dr. S. Rajasekaran was elcted President of World Orthopaedic Concern.

Editorial Secretary's report:

Dr. C. Raja Ravi Varma handed out a model of the new-look News Letter, which was circulated to all the members and was appreciated by everyone. He detailed that he had plans of adding new features like Academic Thrusts, Meet the Personality, Zonal News, Achievements galore etc. such a way that the news letter would make interesting reading. He also felt that contacting committee members to gather news from zones was pretty difficult and hence gave a general request to the zonal committee members to voluntarily provide news from their zones whatever the content may be.

He also further stated that the Journal of the TNOA would also be upgraded with various new features and would thrive to make the TNOA Journal a listed journal.

Fellowship Secretary's Report:

Dr. S. Sundar informed the gathering about the process of finalizing the venue for this year's Fellowship programme. Various venues were discussed.

Foreign Fellowship

Regarding the Foreign Fellowship there was detailed discussion on the criteria to be considered. He also said that certain areas were to be considered and understood in detail. He proposed the selection criteria and the members also gave their suggestions.

- It was decided to award 2 marks for MS Degree while no marks would be allotted for FRCS or M.Ch.
- It was decided to exclude the clause of Teaching Experience to enable those form non- teaching institutes as well.
- Co-authors of Publications were to be excluded.
- Contributions of publications to Books to be excluded.
- It was decided to exclude lectures in CMEs, Guest Lectures, Social Works, convening of Workshop from the criteria.
- It was decided that the TNOA shall confirm the venue.
- The APOA may be communicated to co-ordinate with the TNOA Foreign Fellowship Programme. Similarly sub-speciality organizations also may be contacted to locate centers of excellence.
- The age limit has to be fixed at 45 years.
- The President, Secretary and Fellowship Secretary of the TNOA shall be the members of the selection committee for the Foreign Fellowship and the decision of the Committee shall be final.
- As for the expense any extra expenditure incurred may be borne by the candidate.

Pondicherry S. Annamalai Reddiar TNOA Travelling Fellowship

Pondicherry S. Annamalai Reddiar TNOA Travelling Fellowship has been abolished and suggestions were made to initiate the Fellowship by the Association itself.

"New Travelling Fellowship":

At this juncture Dr. R. Muralidharan, Executive Committee member from Central Zone and Dr. R. Sivakumar, committee member from Madurai offered to sponsor a new fellowship, which was readily accepted by the Committee. The details were to be worked out.

TNOA Format!

It was felt that the routine formats could be given a thought for change and hence discussions were on to get members' opinion on the various patterns/type of lectures/presentations etc. It was decided to publish an opinion poll in the forthcoming News Letter to call for members' opinion. Discussion also centered around reduction of Orations to 30 minutes, restriction of medal papers to 6-8, increase the Interactive sessions etc.

Protocol:

It was generally felt that certain protocols were glaringly missing during the Inaugural functions of the TNOA CON Cuddalore. It was strongly opined that as TNOA happens to be the prime body of governance the President and Secretary of the TNOA should be given due recognition in such events. In fact the President TNOA shall inaugurate the CME programme, members felt.

TNOA 2006

Dr. Singaravelu, representing the TNOA CON 2006 organising committee as well, briefed the committee of the arrangements at Chennai.

TNOA Membership Directory:

The TNOA membership directory was being updated according to the Secretary who also requested the zonal Executive members to help in finding out the current address of members. He also requested the Editorial Secretary to publish the list of members unable to be contacted in the forthcoming News Letter.

IOA Projects:

The Secretary read out the various proposals of the IOA with reference to the World Trauma Day and the National Initiative of Trauma Awareness Rally to be held on the 16th of October.

At this juncture Dr. David Rajan, President Elect, TNOA felt that the TNOA should strive to draw the attention of the Government both at the State and Centre to the menace that increasing number of vehicular traffic and the types of vehicle create on the road.

Dr. M. Chidambaram, Vice President, TNOA felt that TNOA should also take up programmes like Trauma Awareness and Osteoporosis Awareness camps. Awareness on road safety should be initiated at School level for best results according to him.

Badminton Tournament:

It was decided to contact and request the Salem Ortho Club to pay Rs 25,000/= towards the Badminton Tournament conducted during the TNOA Conference.

Contribution to TNOA

The Executive Committee requested the Organising Committee of the TNOA 2006 to enhance the contribution amount from the Conference revenue to Rs. 1.5 lac

TNOA Gesture:

The services of Dr. H. P. Lutz of Germany were commended and it was suggested to confer Honorary Membership to him.

The meeting finally came to an end with a vote of thanks by Dr. S.G. Thirumalaisamy.

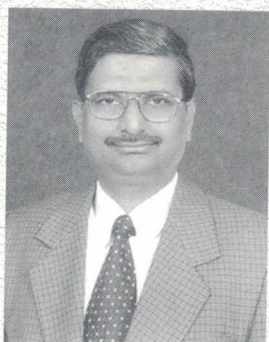
TNOACON – 2006 CHENNAI

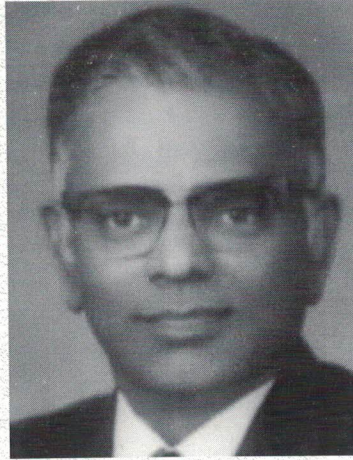

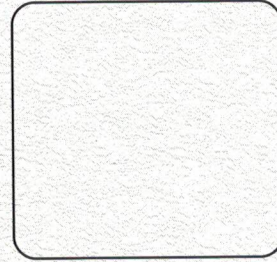

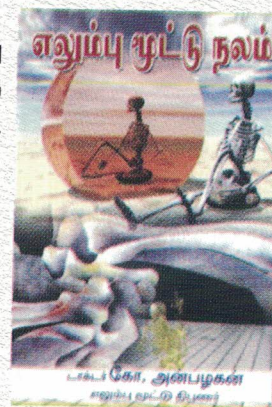

Guidelines to Authors

Two copies of the manuscript along with print version in MS word on a CD and neat and clear illustrations should be submitted.

Preparation of manuscript : Type manuscript on white bond paper 22 x 28 cm with liberal margins of atleast 2.5 cm. Use double spacing including title page, abstract, text acknowledgements, references, tables and legends of illustrations. Begin each of the following sections on separate pages. Number pages consecutive, in the upper right corner of each page.

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2. A short running head of foot line of no more than 40 characters,
3. First name, Middle and last name with initial of each author.
4. Name of Co author(s)
5. Name of department(s) and institution(s) to which the work should be attributed,
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Abstract : An informative abstract of about 150 words must accompany each manuscript, it should be suitable for use by abstracting journals and include data on the problem method and materials, results and conclusion.,

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References : In the text should include only those that are important and have been studied in fully by the authors. Case reports and other short submission should be sent in the format of a full paper including and abstract and caption.
