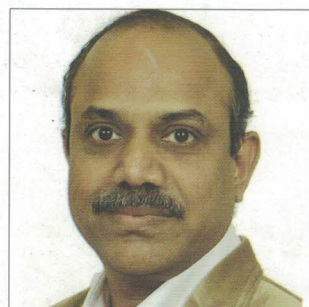

The meeting called to order by 9.30 am

Welcome Address - Dr. R. Siva Kumar, President

Prof. Dr. R. Siva Kumar, President welcomed all the members and in his presidential address he discussed on the following topics.

Presidential Theme "EXPLORE TAMILNADU" Public Awareness programmes and CME's to be conducted in suburban and rural areas within 5 months.

For Bone and Joint day programmes, Secretary was appreciated for organizing the programmes in an excellent manner and executing the programmes. He also thanked IOA president and National Co-ordinator of IOA Dr. Raja Ravi Varma for this extended co-operation.

President thanked Dr. Muralidharan for conducting the Extraordinary EC meeting held at Dindugal.

He thanked all the EC members for their support and asked them to follow up immediately in collection of documents, datas, reports, hard copies from the members who have performed surgeries. As per reports in Tamilnadu 230 surgeries performed and documents received for 94 surgeries in complete and 17 reports were incomplete due to first witness particulars not given.

President thanked all members for lending their support and co-operation for the conduction of free surgeries for the world record and said that copy of all the documents of the surgeries sent to IOA should be send to TNOA.

He especially congratulated and appreciated the South Zone for performing most number of surgeries. He informed CERTIFICATES will be given from TNOA for the participated orthopaedicians. He informed that Academic panel to be constituted and it should be continuous process.

Academic Panel

Stage 1

Selection of these Academicians, are only arbitrary as of now in the 1st stage. The term "arbitrary" means he/she

can be chosen or suggested by any EC Members or his comrades from that district without any prejudice / without any selection criteria.

Stage 2

Those who are selected arbitrary will be put up in common pool, TNOA will ask their commitment for their academic deliberations, attendance in TNOA CME's & Conferences, obliging TNOA's request to go as a faculty within the state or outside the state.

Stage 3

Once the faculty gives their commitments to the TNOA by mail or letters they will be sorted out in the Academic Panel.

Academic Panel – FAQ

1. Who are the members to be selected? Is there any age limit?

Members to be selected are Teaching Faculty, Technical Experts in any corporate and no age limit.

2. Will the teaching institution faculty alone be selected?

Teaching Institution Faculty may be selected. Apart from the teaching faculty any member faculty who is active, interested in teaching will be part of the panel who can be young or old, in metro or mofussil towns Hospitals.

3. Are retired people eligible?

Retired faculty Members who are also active in practice are eligible.

4. What is the advantage for TNOA?

TNOA will be armed with best committed Panel Members in the speciality to deliver the best of speciality guidelines & practice to the upcoming juniors. The presence of committed Panel Members empowers TNOA to conduct Academics without hassle. The list of committed Panel Members will be ready at any given part of time.

5. What advantage do the Members get?

Member will be a part of renowned panel & Prestigious Organization, it will nourish the Academic zeal & carrier growth of

The Member and they will get the certificate of accreditation from the Association.

6. Will this list be final?

The list can be altered from time to time with more of additions & less of deletions

7. Do we need any minimum years of experience after P.G to enable him to be included in panel?

5 years

8. Do we need to get individual surgeon's consent regarding where he wants to be enlisted (Spine, Trauma, Arthroplasty, Arthroscopy, Paediatrics)

You need not. TNOA will ask their interest of ORTHOPAEDICS & their commitment after you have suggested their names.

9. Can a surgeon be included in all sub specialities?

Depends on his caliber & commitment

10. Everybody does trauma surgeries, how to choose trauma panel?

Even in single panel hoe to fix the order of surgeons.

This will be finalized by the EC at the concluding stage.

Now only BOA is having a similar panel. He requested the

Co-operation of all members to make TNOA a role model to other states. He restricted that faculties must have commitments not only to their specialities but also towards TNOA.

National Bone and Joint Day

President invited Dr. C.Raja Ravi Varma National Co-ordinator of Bone & Joint day of IOA to present his deliberations – Dr.Raja Ravi Varma

Appreciated the president and the secretary for their excellent efforts in the conduction of bone & joint day surgeries. He congratulated all the EC members and all the members for their co-operation. He informed that in India the surgeries were conducted in 22 states, and officially 649 members have done more than 1000 surgeries and 500 or more not being reported officially. He informed that TNOA stood first with 115 surgeries performed of which 17 were with incomplete documents. The incomplete documents are due to wrong addressee, patient name not written, doctors not signed the second page of the undertaking forms, First witness particulars not properly filled up

(he had made amendments by getting the signatures from the lawyer of IOA), image of surgeries, scanned copy of the News paper articles covering the entire page. He said that he had sent an e mail blast regarding this.

He also informed that the Spirit is more important than the numbers.

He told all the documents should be routed through TNOA to IOA, but many of them have directly to IOA official mail id instead of sending to the mail created for this purpose ioabjd2016@gmail.com. He has requested the world record association to extend some more time to complete the procedure of compilation of reports. He requested the EC members to collect all completed forms and send it to TNOA within Wednesday. Only after that the final figures can be obtained. The surgeries done in private hospitals were taken into account and not the ones conducted in Government hospitals. Certificates will be given to the members who have done the surgeries appreciating their participation.

President thanked the national co-ordinator and told TNOA took a stand and contributed with whole heart and the secretary will help to send the list of doctors have submitted documents and if necessary will be send again if needed.

FREE PAPERS MEDAL to improve upon the academic side of TNOA

Prof. Dr. R. Sivakumar, President said that Arthroscopy/ Arthroplasty/ Foot and ankle/ Spine/ Paediatric ortho, Orthopaedic oncology free paper medals will be formed and requested TNOACON to formulate papers in the same category and to give medals and certificates in the above category also

Dr. Muralidharan told that in 2008, best papers in each session were given certificates.

Dr. Selvaraj opined that Certificates can be started.

Dr. Ramesh Babu recommended instead of free papers, best paper certificate plus medal can be given.

Dr. Raja Ravi Varma clarified that for Specialty Medal since No donor was available there were no medals given but certificates were given. Dr. Sundarrajan insisted that Foot and ankle surgery to be included and told there are already 200 members in the Foot and Ankle society.

Dr. Sivakumar informed that suggestion was well taken by the EC.

Dr. Thirumalaichichamy informed Medals are given for meritorious papers.

Prof. Dr. R. Sivakumar, President stressed the need of Criteria in Brochure. Dr. Ramesh Babu told Best paper should be mentioned and informed.

Dr. Sugavanam recommended 1 Medal, 1 Candidate, 1 paper.

Dr. Raja Ravi Varma opined if we could get the donor members –medals on trial basis can be given by organizing committee.

Two copies of the manuscript along with print version in MS word on a CD and neat and clear illustrations should be submitted. In case one wishes to send articles on-line, it should be sent in word document format for written materials. Pictures must be sent in a C.D. only by post/courier.

Preparation of manuscript: Type manuscript on white bond paper 22 x 28 cm with liberal margins of at least 2.5 cm. Use double spacing including title page, abstract, text acknowledgements, references, tables and legends of illustrations. Begin each of the following sections on separate pages. Number pages consecutive, in the upper right corner of each page.

Title Page: The title page should contain

1. The title of the article, which should be concise but informative,
2. A short running head or foot line of no more than 40 characters,
3. First name, Middle and last name with initial of each author.
4. Name of Co author(s)
5. Name of department(s) and institution(s) to which the work should be attributed,
6. Disclaimers, if any
7. Name and address of author including phone number/mobile number and e-mail if any, for any clarifications.
8. The source of support in the form of grants, equipment, drugs, none or all of these.

Abstract: An informative abstract of about 150 words must accompany each manuscript, it should be suitable for use by abstracting journals and include data on the problem method and materials, results and conclusion.

Key (Indexing) terms: Below the abstract, provide and identify as such, three to ten key words or short phrases that may be published with the abstract and that will assist indexers in cross-indexing your article. Use terms from the medical subject heading list from the Index Medicus whenever possible.

Introduction: Acquaint the readers with the problem and quote the most pertinent paper. Mention clearly the purpose of the work.

Material and Methods: Explain in detail, elaborately and clearly, your clinical, technical or experimental procedures. Previously published methods should be cited only in appropriate references. **Mention the number of patients or cases in words e.g five patients instead of 5 patients.**

Results: Describe your findings without comment. Include a concise textual description of the data presented in tables, charts and figures. **Please prepare tables/charts as a separate document in word and send as separate folder without mixing up in the word document.**

Discussion: Comment on your results and relate them to those of other authors, define their significance for experimental research of clinical practice. Arguments must be well founded.

Tables: Tables should be self-explanatory and should supplement, not duplicate the text. Type each table on a separate sheet with double space. Number tables consecutively with a brief title for each. Give each column a short abbreviated heading. Place explanatory matter in footnotes. If you use data from another published or unpublished source, obtain permission and acknowledge fully. **Please prepare tables as a separate document in word and send as separate folder without mixing up in the word document.**

Illustrations: Use only those illustrations that clarify and increase understanding of the text. All illustrations must be numbered and cited in the text. Two black and white glossy print photographs of each illustration should be submitted. The following information should be typed on a gummed label and affixed to the back of each illustration; figure number, title of manuscript, Name of senior author, and arrow indicating top. Please do not write in ink at the back of the photograph. All illustrations have to be sent, as separate JPEG image files in a C.D. Colour pictures are also welcome.

A word on scanning or digital imaging: It is preferable to scan pictures in 300 dpi. If pictures already taken have to be chosen please use Photoshop and save as jpeg in minimum 300 resolutions. Digital images may be made in 3.0 or more mega pixels. This will help in prevention of distortion of pictures when enlarged.

Legends for illustrations: Type legends/captions for illustrations double - spaced, starting on separate page with arabic numerals corresponding to the illustrations.

References:

In the text should include only those that are important and have been studied in fully by the authors. References are a must for any article and those without references would be rejected.

Case Reports are welcome and such case reports and other short submission should be sent in the format of a full paper including and abstract and captions.

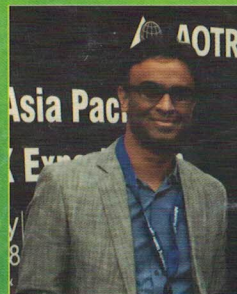
'Dr Velasamy Raveendran had been elected as Nails Association of Interlocking Surgeons of India.'

Dr. Palanikumar from Erode gave a Lecture On Endoscopic Discectomy In International Conference At Kolkata (ICRA).

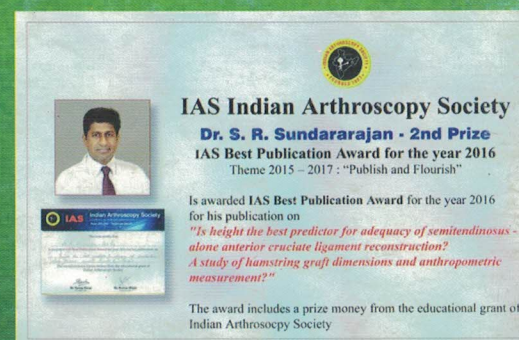


Ashok S Gavaskar from Chennai has the following achievements:
