

4. Academic Expert Panel:

President, Dr.Ramesh Babu appreciated the immediate Past President Dr.Siva Kumar's role which was useful for choosing the faculty and chair persons for TNOACON, OASICON and IOACON. In this regard, President has sent e-mail to all EC members & they are requested to send names immediately as OASICON is nearing. List of orthopaedic surgeons who will be willing to actively participate as faculty & chair persons only should be recommended. Dr. SivaKumar sent few names & EC Members are requested to suggest names at the earliest.

Dr. SivaKumar said that these experts will also hold good for all legal issues like second opinions & affidavits.

He assured that Indexing work will be fastened up and requested all EC members to contribute articles for TNOA Journal.

He elaborated about all TNOA fellowships.

X. TREASURER'S REPORT - DR. V. THIRUNARAYANAN

It was decided to conduct a meeting with the auditor & builders before next EC Meeting.

XI. REPORT – ORGANISING SECRETARY TNOACON 2017 – Dr. VETRIVEL CHEZHIAN

Since Dr. Vettrivel Chezhian was not able to attend the EC meeting due to personal reasons, he already had sent the report & cheques to TNOA as detailed below:

- i. Seed money – Rs. 5 lakhs
- ii. Proceedings from conference to TNOA - Rs. 3 lakhs
- iii. Journal fund – Rs. 1,64,800/-
- iv. Website maintenance - Rs. 40,000/-

Dr. Siva Kumar, immediate past president thanked the Coimbatore Ortho Society & Coimbatore Medical College for the excellent conduct of the conference. He also appreciated the prompt handing over of cheques to TNOA.

XII. REPORT – ORGANISING SECRETARY TNOACON-2018 - Dr. S. KRISHNA KUMAR

He briefed about the already made arrangements & meetings conducted. Venue is Ganga grandeur Nagercoil. He informed that Auditor has been fixed and corpus fund of RS. 5,00,000/- collected from members of Kanyakumari Ortho club and so seed money may not be needed from the association.

He informed that they formed Kanyakumari orthopaedics association instead of Kanyakumari orthopaedic Society, as registration is difficult and also to change the Pan card & Account name which are in the name of Kanyakumari orthopaedics association.

President, Dr. Ramesh Babu stressed that a new pan card be applied with name changed. Dr. Francis Roy highlighted that in 2016 GB itself it was passed that only TNOA can use the word association & affiliated branches can have the name as ortho clubs or society. Dr. Meenakshi Sundaram, fellowship secretary pointed out that during conduction of Salem TNOACON a separate account & Pan card was obtained for TNOACON. This separate Pan card is better as local club would attract lot of taxation.

The EC and President stressed that once the GB has approved the name of branches as clubs or society, the EC has no powers to overlook it. So that this has to be set aside and new pan card as KK Ortho club or society should be applied for.

Dr. Muralidharan suggested that a pan card as TNOACON 2018 could be applied for under KK orthopaedic society by passing a resolution in the local club, to rename it as club or society. Dr. Siva Kumar suggested that to call a meeting of the club members & pass resolution for change of name from association to club & register. Then change the present pan card with conference logo.

President concluded that it should be registered as Kanyakumari ortho club or society and should not be printed as association in future communications.

Dr. Krishna Kumar presented the brochure and wanted to conduct the conference as paper less conference with one announcement in printed and rest electronic announcements.

Secretary insisted that all brochures should be sent to president & secretary before printing for approval.

Discussion on paperless conference: It was decided that regular printed format especially the second announcement to be sent by post.

Dr. Krishna Kumar also informed that website for the conference is updated with payment portal on website made available.

It was unanimously decided that the contribution to TNOA would be Rs. 3,50,000/- from this conference (TNOACON2018, Nagercoil).

Dr. R. Selva Raj, vice president OASIS was honoured by President. 1st EC meeting of OASIS was conducted on 9th April in Chennai.

The List of New Life Members of TNOA (105) along with the contribution towards OASIS (Rs.10500/-) handed over to the Secretary General of OASIS.

OASIS TRAUMACON is to be conducted on 5th August, 2017 at Taj Krishna Hotel, Hyderabad.

OASIS Journal handed over to Wolters Kluwer for indexing.

Each state has 5th EC member in the EC of OASIS. The vice president & Joint Secretary would be also included in the EC member of OASIS as per president's suggestion.

OASISCON 2018 will be held in September- 1st to 3rd at Manipal. Organising Secretary is Dr. Sharath Rao.

Dr. M. Chidamabaram from Madurai, Past President of TNOA will be honoured this time in OASISCON as decided by GB and OASIS secretary general from Tamil Nadu is Dr. Nalli Yuvraj as decided in GB. Prof. R. H. Govardhan (Past President of TNOA & Past secretary of IOA) will be delivering the SSK Marthandam oration in OASISCON.

OASIS PG Quiz - Team from Tamil Nadu to be nominated for OASIS PG Quiz: In few States, only second year PGs are allowed to participate in the State Level PG Quiz so that the same winning team will participate in the OASIS as well as IOA level quiz programs also. It was proposed that in TNOA quiz, the participants should be I year and II year PGs so that they will be available for OASIS and IOA quiz competitions and it was approved by EC.

It is decided to invite IOA & OASIS office bearers to the state conference, TNOACON as mandatory.

Dr. Nalli Yuvraj has requested that Dr. Nalli Gopinath, past Treasurer of TNOA to be the next treasurer of OASIS which is ratified by the EC.

XIX. IOA MATTERS:

President, Dr. Ramesh Babu attended the EC Meeting & CSRC meeting in Delhi along with Dr. Rajamani, Dr. Raja Ravi Varma & Dr. Deen Mohammed Ismail.

The Annual Conference of IOA will be held at Indore from 26th December to 31st December 2017. Guest Nation for IOACON Indore is Malaysia. Abstract submission extended to 31st May. Rolling trophy for best city club is also proposed. President theme is "Integration for Enrichment". Various Programmes discussed: increasing membership, Mobile app, Yura Mentorship Programme already sent information to 50 members and among them 25 Doctors accepted.

Dr. N. Nazeer Ahmed has been made Co-ordinator for Centers of Excellence & Yuva Mentorship in Tamil Nadu.

This year too Bone & Joint Day free surgery programme to be conducted. Dr. Raja Ravi Varma will be the Co-ordinator for the Programme.

XX. ANY OTHER MATTERS:

1. Medico Legal Matters:

Dr. Narshima Rao, Trichy presented his presentation and briefed on various aspects of Medico legal & litigation guidelines. President stressed the importance of consent and need to get a proper consent. The consent letter form is to be dealt by Doctors, not nurses.

2. Letter from Dr. S. Elangovan from Salem who feels neglected as he has been promised to be honoured in the seniors above 70 years in Coimbatore during TNOACON 2017. He will be honoured by our President during his visit to

Salem. It was resolved that honouring the seniors during the TNOACON is the responsibility of the TNOACON organisers. It is the responsibility of the TNOACON organisers to apologise & not TNOA. So letter has to be sent by the organisers of TNOACON 2017 through TNOA.

3. Conduction of banquet during TNOACON-Dr.Selvam's letter: President, Dr.Ramesh Babu suggested that the name "Alcohol" should not be mentioned in the banquet or any print. Dr.Krishna Kumar, organising Secretary TNOACON 2018 suggested that no more "Alcohol" will be served during the conferences and "Alcohol" will be served only in banquets that are conducted outside conference venue. 




Tamil Nadu Orthopaedic Journal

Two copies of the manuscript along with print version in MS word on a CD and neat and clear illustrations should be submitted. In case one wishes to send articles on-line, it should be sent in word document format for written materials. Pictures must be sent in a C.D. only by post/courier.

Preparation of manuscript: Type manuscript on white bond paper 22 x 28 cm with liberal margins of at least 2.5 cm. Use double spacing including title page, abstract, text acknowledgements, references, tables and legends of illustrations. Begin each of the following sections on separate pages. Number pages consecutive, in the upper right corner of each page.

Title Page: The title page should contain

1. The title of the article, which should be concise but informative,
2. A short running head or foot line of no more than 40 characters,
3. First name, Middle and last name with initial of each author.
4. Name of Co author(s)
5. Name of department(s) and institution(s) to which the work should be attributed,
6. Disclaimers, if any
7. Name and address of author including phone number/mobile number and e-mail if any, for any clarifications.
8. The source of support in the form of grants, equipment, drugs, none or all of these.

Abstract: An informative abstract of about 150 words must accompany each manuscript, it should be suitable for use by abstracting journals and include data on the problem method and materials, results and conclusion.

Key (Indexing) terms: Below the abstract, provide and identify as such, three to ten key words or short phrases that may be published with the abstract and that will assist indexers in cross-indexing your article. Use terms from the medical subject heading list from the Index Medicus whenever possible.

Introduction: Acquaint the readers with the problem and quote the most pertinent paper. Mention clearly the purpose of the work.

Material and Methods: Explain in detail, elaborately and clearly, your clinical, technical or experimental procedures. Previously published methods should be cited only in appropriate references. Mention the number of patients or cases in words e.g five patients instead of 5 patients.

Results: Describe your findings without comment. Include a concise textual description of the data presented in tables, charts and figures. Please prepare tables/charts as a separate document in word and send as separate folder without mixing up in the word document.

Discussion: Comment on your results and relate them to those of other authors, define their significance for experimental research of clinical practice. Arguments must be well founded.

Tables: Tables should be self-explanatory and should supplement, not duplicate the text. Type each table on a separate sheet with double space. Number tables consecutively with a brief title for each. Give each column a short abbreviated heading. Place explanatory matter in footnotes. If you use data from another published or unpublished source, obtain permission and acknowledge fully. Please prepare tables as a separate document in word and send as separate folder without mixing up in the word document.

Illustrations: Use only those illustrations that clarify and increase understanding of the text. All illustrations must be numbered and cited in the text. Two black and white glossy print photographs of each illustration should be submitted. The following information should be typed on a gummed label and affixed to the back of each illustration; figure number, title of manuscript, Name of senior author, and arrow indicating top. Please do not write in ink at the back of the photograph. All illustrations have to be sent, as separate JPEG image files in a C.D. Colour pictures are also welcome.

A word on scanning or digital imaging: It is preferable to scan pictures in 300 dpi. If pictures already taken have to be chosen please use Photoshop and save as jpeg in minimum 300 resolutions. Digital images may be made in 3.0 or more mega pixels. This will help in prevention of distortion of pictures when enlarged.

Legends for illustrations: Type legends/captions for illustrations double - spaced, starting on separate page with arabic numerals corresponding to the illustrations.

References:

In the text should include only those that are important and have been studied in fully by the authors. References are a must for any article and those without references would be rejected.


Case Reports are welcome and such case reports and other short submission should be sent in the format of a full paper including and abstract and captions.
